children need boundaries to feel safe. However, in the search for independence, children are bound to push limits. When that happens, it's good to give children choices. Rather than simply saying, "You need to pick up the blocks," give the child a choice. Ask, "Do you want to pick up the red or the green blocks first?" This approach lets children learn to obey while still feeling in control of their choices. As you help children learn to obey the people in authority over them—like parents and teachers—you're also helping them learn what it means to obey God.

## God Gives the Ten Commandments

(Part 1) Exodus 19:16–20:21



BIBLE BACKGROUND FOR LEADERS

This week's Bible Background concentrates on the events surrounding the giving of the Ten Commandments, while next week's concentrates on the commandments themselves. You may want to read both Bible Backgrounds before beginning this lesson.

## The Israelites Battle the Amalekites

The Amalekites attacked the Israelites where they were camped. God had prepared the Israelites' faith for this test through his provision for them in so many ways. So the Israelites put together an army under the leadership of Joshua and went on the attack. Moses held high in the air the staff that had struck the rock to get water—"the staff of God." As long as Moses held the staff in the air, the Israelites continued to win—so Aaron and Hur helped hold Moses' hands up, and the Israelites defeated the Amalekites (Exodus 17:8-16).

# Jethro Advises Moses to Focus on God

Moses' father-in-law, Jethro, came to visit after the battle with the Amalekites. Seeing Moses burdened with judging disagreements among the 2 million Israelites, Jethro gave Moses some good advice. He suggested that Moses appoint judges to serve the people so that Moses could concentrate on what was most important—being the people's representative before God. Moses took the advice and then led the Israelites on to Mount Sinai, where Moses had previously met God in the burning bush. They arrived at Mount Sinai three months to the day from when they left Egypt (Exodus 18:5–19:2).

### Moses Receives the Commandments From God

A significant event is recorded in the next few verses (Exodus 19:3-9): God spoke to Moses and promised

him that Israel would be his treasured possession, his holy people—if they would obey him. After Moses told the people what God had said, they responded gratefully: "We will do everything the Lord has said." God responded by telling Moses that God himself would come down and speak with the Israelites from a cloud.

The law God gave spelled out how the Israelites were to honor him through their obedience. In the thousands of years that have passed since this event, one thing hasn't changed: The best way we can honor God is by obeying him.

### **The Jesus Connection**

Following Jesus is not about obeying rules; it's about knowing him. However, our obedience in honoring and glorifying God in our everyday lives allows our relationship with Jesus to grow.

### **Show Our Love**

### What You'll Do

Hold an infant on your lap. Place the "Ten Commandments" teaching picture in front of the baby.

Say: Moses went up to the top of a mountain to talk with God. God said, "I love you and want to give you rules to keep you safe." The first rule says we should love God. We show God our love by obeying his rules. Help baby pat the picture while you say: We ▶ OBEY GOD.



## Stick With God's Love

### What You'll Do

Remove a heart sticker from the sticker sheet. Seat an infant on your lap.

Say: God always loves you. We make God happy by obeying him. Hold the heart sticker in front of the baby. This heart shows God's love for you. God loves every part of you. Gently stick part of the sticker on baby's arm. God loves your arms. Peel off the sticker. Stick it on baby's leg. God loves your legs. Peel off the sticker. Place it on the front of baby's head. Just as this sticker shows God's love for you, we show God we love him when we obey him. We DBEY GOD.

Hold the heart sticker on your fingers, and allow the baby to touch it. To avoid a choking hazard, don't allow baby to hold the sticker.

## Name Game

### What You'll Do

Repeat the first sound of a baby's name as you do this chant face to face. For example, Sebina would be "Se-se-se-Sebina."

## **Love and Obey**

### What You'll Do

Sit on the floor with one or two toddlers. Open your Bible to Exodus 19, and show children the words. Tell them the Bible is God's special book.

Say: God asked Moses to climb a big mountain. Up, up, up! Sit up and stretch higher and higher as you speak. When Moses got to the top of the mountain, God gave him two big rock tablets with rules on them. Moses took the rules down the mountain and told the people about them.

Hold up the "Ten Commandments" teaching picture for children to see. Say: God gave us rules because he loves us. The first rule says we're to love God. One way we can show God we love him is by obeying his rules. Let's cover the tablets with hearts to remember that when we DBEY GOD, we show him we love him.

Give kids each a heart sticker to place on the tablets in the picture to remember that when they obey God, it shows they love God. Sing "Love the Lord Your God" (not on the CD) to the tune of "The Farmer in the Dell" as children place their heart stickers.

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### Ten Commandments Countdown

### What You'll Do

Gather 10 blocks or toys near you. Hold a toddler on your lap.

Say: God loved us so much that he gave us 10 rules to live by. We call these the Ten Commandments. We show God we love him by following his rules. We have 10 blocks in front of us. Let's count to 10 together. Take the toddler's hand in yours, and count the 10 blocks.

Say: **You also have 10 fingers. Let's count your fingers.** Gently touch each of the toddler's fingers as you count to 10. Say this rhyme as you count with him or her.

Say: One, two, three,
God loves me.
Four, five, six,
Rules God picks.
Seven, eight, nine,
God loves us all the time.
Ten, ten, ten,
Let's count God's rules again.
One, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten!

### What You'll Do

Call a few toddlers to join you in sitting on the floor.

Say: The first rule God gave us says we're to love God. Let's think about times we can tell God we love him. Lead toddlers in following you in this simple movement activity.

## God Gives the Ten Commandments

### What You'll Do

Gather a group of 2-year-olds together. Let them look at the half of the poster with Moses holding the stone tablets. Open your Bible to Exodus 19, and show children the words. Tell them the Bible is God's special book.

Say: Today we're going to hear how God gave Moses the Ten Commandments. In the desert, God called to Moses. He said "Moses." Lead the children in saying "Moses" in a deep, booming voice.

Say: **God said, "Moses, I want you to meet me on top of this high mountain."** Have the children stretch up on their toes to reach high in the sky like a high mountain. **So Moses climbed the mountain.** Make climbing motions with the children. Then have children sit down.

### God Gives the Ten Commandments Easy Prep

Cut the "God Gives the Ten Commandments" poster in half. Then cut out the stone tablets from the right half of the poster. Display the left half of the poster (showing Moses holding the stone tablets) where you'll gather the children for the Bible Exploration time.



Say: When Moses got to the top of the mountain, God gave him two stone tablets. Hold up the Ten Commandments tablets. The tablets had rules on them. The first rule said to love God. When we love God, it makes God happy. Lead children in hugging themselves while saying "love." Next have them point up and say "God." Make a game of leading children in repeating these motions faster and faster.

Say: God gave the same rules to Moses that he wants us to keep today, and the first rule is "Love God." When we ▶ OBEY GOD, we show him we love him. Help each child place a heart sticker on the stone tablets as he or she says, "We love God."

After the lesson, remove the heart stickers from the stone tablets and place the tablets back in the Teacher Pack for use in a later lesson.

## **Growing With Jesus**



### Establishing Early Rules

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As you teach young children about rules, let them know rules are designed to keep us safe and happy. Having too many rules often makes children insecure about when they're going to step over the line. Having too few (or unenforced) rules causes a child to feel adrift rather than connected to an important support system. So it's wise to have just enough rules to keep track of—just as God gave the Ten Commandments.

For now, make sure the rules are simple and memorable. For example, "Obey and be kind."



our child learned the first commandment and that we obey God (from Exodus 19:16–20:21). Your child participated in one of the following activities today. You can use these activities with your child to help your child grow with Jesus throughout the week.
