The Israelites Worship a Golden Calf

Exodus 32:1-25



BIBLE BACKGROUND FOR LEADERS

Out of Sight

Moses was up on the mountain for a long time receiving all the laws from God—almost six weeks (Exodus 24:18)! It's likely that the Israelites feared Moses had perished on the mountain. Since he had been their main contact with God, they may have reasoned that they had lost contact with God, too.

The Hebrews spent more than 400 years seeing "gods" in Egypt, and now they'd been asked to serve and follow a God they couldn't see. For the majority of the time they'd known God, he'd had personal relationships with individuals among them. They may not have realized God was interested in each of them individually and as an entire community.

They'd been camped in the same place for six weeks and were likely getting anxious to move on. They couldn't even see God's representative, so they fell back on what they were familiar with and asked for a god they could see who would continue to lead them.

What Was Aaron Thinking?

Aaron's willingness to go along suggests that he, too, had some doubt about Moses' return. However, some believe that Aaron's request for gold earrings was an attempt to avert the people's desire for a god. If they realized they had to give up things of value, they might decide they didn't really want a golden god after all. If that was Aaron's intent, his attempt failed.

After making the idol, Aaron's proclamation was that there'd be a "festival to the Lord." The name translated Lord (Yahweh) is the name by which God had announced himself to Moses at the burning bush. Apparently, Aaron thought that this idol could somehow represent the true God. Regardless of his motives, Aaron was wrong in making the idol. He led the people in disobeying God's second commandment (Exodus 20:4).

In talking to Moses, Aaron tried to make it seem as if he had no choice and that the fire itself had mysteriously shaped the calf. God's sparing of Aaron in this situation was certainly an example of his mercy and grace.

We are surrounded by things that promise to bring us

immediate pleasure and satisfaction. Many of these

promises are deceitful, leading to destruction. But even God's blessings themselves can distract us from our true calling of worshipping God. Jesus came to offer the only thing that's truly worth having. Take a moment to write a prayer revealing your heart's desire to follow God and asking for his help in dislodging some things that might be stealing your worship away from God.

What You'll Do

Hold up a yellow dot sticker from the sticker sheet for a baby to see. Help baby feel the sticky back and smooth front of the sticker. Guide baby in putting the sticker on the calf in the teaching picture.

Say: In the Bible, the Israelites made a golden calf. The people liked the golden calf and thought it was special. But God said, "No golden idols!" Moses crushed the calf and threw it away. Show baby how to crumple the paper. Then let him or her crumple it. Moses got rid of the calf because nothing else is special like God. God is the only God. We should ▶ WORSHIP ONLY GOD.

Worship Only God

What You'll Do

Sit on the floor with a couple of toddlers. Open your Bible to Exodus 32:1-25, and show children the words. Tell them the Bible is God's special book.

Say: In the Bible, the Israelites made a golden calf. Hold up a yellow dot sticker from the sticker sheet. This is yellow, like gold. Give each child a copy of the golden calf picture. Help each toddler put a yellow dot sticker on the calf. The people liked the calf and thought it was special. Moses was very angry with the people for making the golden calf. He told the people that the calf was not special like God. He took the calf from the people. He tore it into pieces. Guide each child in tearing a piece from his or her copy of the golden calf picture and throwing the torn piece into a trash can. Set aside each child's picture with his or her name on it to take home.

Say: Moses said, "No more gold calves! Only God is special. He's the only one you should worship. God is number one! WORSHIP ONLY GOD!" Have children point upward and repeat the words after you.



Worship No Other Gods

What You'll Do

Say: The Israelites decided to make a statue to worship. The people collected their gold and made a giant calf. Let's use these yellow stickers to make our calf look like their golden calf. Give each child a yellow dot sticker from the sticker sheet to put on the calf. Demonstrate how to put the dots inside the outline of the calf on the teaching picture. Let children continue to work as you speak.

Say: The people thought their golden calf was special. They prayed to the calf. They worshipped the calf. They pretended their calf was God! But God wasn't happy with the people. God wanted the people to worship only him. So Moses took away the calf and got rid of it. Take the calf picture from the children, and put it away out of sight. Moses said, "God is very special. He wants us to worship only him."

There were lots of people listening to Moses. Moses wanted to make sure everyone heard what he said. Let's help Moses pass this important message to everyone. Hold up the star. This star shape can help us remember that God is special and he wants us to worship him. Give one child the star. Say: God is special. ▶ WORSHIP ONLY GOD. Then have that child hand the star to another child and repeat the words you just said. Help the child if he or she forgets some of the words, or say the words with preverbal twos. Make sure each child has a turn receiving the star and passing the star to someone else.

Say: Now you know the message Moses wanted all God's people to know: God is special. We ▶ WORSHIP ONLY GOD.

These star shapes can help us remember that God is special and he wants us to worship him. Let's decorate our stars to remind us to worship God. Give each child a "Star" handout. Encourage 2-year-olds to dip a paintbrush into the glue and "paint" glue onto the star. Then let them shake glitter onto the glue. Help children shake off the excess glitter. As twos decorate, say: We ▶ WORSHIP ONLY GOD.

Write children's names on their stars. Let children take their stars home as decorations.

Have children re-enact what happened with the golden calf by participating in this action rhyme. As you say the words, lead children in acting out the motions.

Say: The people of Israel, though brave and bold, forgot to worship God as they were told. (shrug shoulders)

They made a calf from bright yellow gold. (pretend to hammer by pounding fists together)

Then they worshipped this calf, this calf made of gold. (bow at the waist)

Moses said, "No, this is not right. Take that golden calf out of my sight!" (look away) God wants us to worship him, and that's what we'll do. (point up; then kneel) God is the only God; the Bible says it's true. (nod your head)

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Growing With Jesus



Concrete Representations

Young children often develop a fascination with men with beards or a special attachment to a picture of Jesus as they try to figure out who God is. They simply need a concrete representation of the one we talk so much about. Pictures help children understand that God is real in the same way that photographs help them keep in touch with distant relatives. If your child doesn't have a picture of Jesus, consider hanging one in his or her room.

INFANT

Say this action rhyme and lead your child in acting out the motions.

Say: The people of Israel, brave and bold, forgot to worship God as they were told. (shrug shoulders)

They made a calf from bright yellow gold. (pretend to hammer by pounding fists together)

Then they worshipped this calf, this calf made of gold. (bow at the waist) Moses said, "No, this is not right. Take that calf out of my sight!" (look away)

God wants us to worship him, and that's what we'll do. (point up; then kneel) God is the only God; the

Afterward, say: Worship only God.

Use these ideas to help your child become a FaithWeaver:

- Point out to your child that one thing that makes God special is that he created everything. Take a walk outside, and talk about what you see that God created.
- Go on a treasure hunt for star shapes. Say this rhyme together whenever you find one:

 God is very special; God is the real star.

 God wants us to worship him, wherever we are.
