Joshua Becomes Leader of Israel

Joshua 1:1-11



God With You

As we begin this passage, Moses had died and Joshua had taken over the leadership of the Israelites, as had been arranged in advance (Deuteronomy 31:1-8). Joshua 1:5 tells us that God was going to be with Joshua in the same way he had been with Moses.

God at Work Through You

The question may arise: Why was it okay for the Israelites to kill other people and take away their land? This is a complicated question. However, one point seems apparent: God was using Israel to judge the immoral people who lived in the land at the time. Just as Israel was later defeated and their land taken away because of sin, so God was using Israel as an instrument of punishment, taking away the land of the Canaanites because of their sin.

God's Plan for You

In this passage God gave Joshua a command of encouragement ("Be strong and courageous"), a condition for success ("obey all the law my servant Moses gave you"), and a promise of his presence ("the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go"). God had a plan for Israel, and Joshua was the instrument through which he was going to accomplish that plan.

God Goes Before You

What more could Joshua ask for? All he had to do was follow what God laid out for him, and God would be there to assure his success. However unsure or discouraged Joshua might have been at the death of Moses, this visit from God rejuvenated him. The first thing recorded after God's message to him is Joshua's ordering the leaders to get the people ready to cross the Jordan. The Israelites were ready to move into the Promised Land, and God was going to give them the land.

The Jesus Connection

Our plans and God's plans don't always match. We want to be happy now; God wants to give us greater joy as we surrender our lives to his service. When we commit our lives to Christ, he uses us to accomplish his mission. God promises the same thing to us that he promised to Joshua: He'll be with us all the time. On the lines below, write a prayer about one area of your life in which you need to know God is with you.

What You'll Do

Hold an infant on your lap. Show the baby the paper doll of Joshua. Allow baby to hold and look at the paper doll.

Say: This is Joshua. He became the leader of Israel after Moses. God was with Joshua. God helped Joshua lead the people. God helped him be strong and brave. ▶ GOD IS WITH US and helps us, too, little [baby's name].

Pray for the baby, thanking God for being with him or her and asking God to give baby the strength and courage to follow God's plan for his or her life.

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3 WEAVING FAITH

God's Help Baby-Bouncer

What You'll Do

Play this game with an active 6- to 12-month-old baby:

Say: **God's with the little wiggle worm.** (hold baby in front of you, and gently move the baby side to side)

God helps the tall giraffe. (lift baby high)

God's with the swinging monkey. (hold baby underneath arms, and gently swing his or her torso)

And God helps [baby's name] **laugh!** (set baby on your lap, and gently tickle his or her tummy)

When you're finished, give the baby a hug.

Say: Just as God is with the animals and helps them, SOD IS WITH US and helps us, too.

What You'll Do

Have an infant lie or sit in front of you on a blanket on the floor.

Say: ► GOD IS WITH US in little and big ways every day. God helps you move your wonderful body. Hold the infant's hands as you clap them. God helps our hands go clap, clap, clap. Thank you, God, for hands that clap!

Gently help the infant kick his or her legs, and say: God helps our legs go kick, kick, kick. Thank you, God, for legs so strong!

Use the infant's hand to help the infant touch his or her nose, and say: **God helps our noses sniff, sniff, sniff. Thank you, God, for noses that smell!** Gather the infant in your arms. **God's with you and helps you with everything you do. I'm so glad** ► **GOD IS WITH US!**

Joshua Leads the People

What You'll Do

Gather a few toddlers together. Blow the whistle gently.

Say: **That was a whistle. When you hear the whistle, put your hands on your head.** Blow the whistle, and encourage children to put their hands on their heads. Practice several times, and then say: **You were good followers.**

Open your Bible to Joshua 1:1-11, and show toddlers the words. Tell them the Bible is God's special book.

Say: The Bible says God's people followed Joshua long ago. Show toddlers the Joshua paper doll. Joshua was their leader. But he didn't lead the people by himself. God was with Joshua, so God's people listened to Joshua, the way you listened to my whistle. Blow the whistle again, and remind toddlers to put their hands on their heads. Just as God was with Joshua, ▶ GOD IS WITH US, too.

Big Ball Bop

What You'll Do

Encourage a toddler to try to hit the inflatable ball while standing under it. Then encourage him or her to lie down and try to kick it. After the toddler makes several attempts, ask if he or she would like your help to reach the ball. Then lift the child.

Say: Because I'm with you, I can help you reach the ball! \blacktriangleright GOD IS WITH US and helps us with things that are too hard for us to do alone, the way I'm helping you reach the ball.

Lift each toddler up, and allow him or her to have a turn giving the ball a big bop.

Obstacle-Course Help

What You'll Do

Say: ► GOD IS WITH US and helps us in all we do. He helps us get around things that get in our way. Let's go over the chair and around the table. Then let's crawl under the table to get back here.

Help each child climb over the top of the chair. Then hold hands, and walk around to the opposite side of the table. Finally, encourage each toddler to crawl under the table. Wait at the other side of the table, encouraging children to finish the obstacle course.

Say: \blacktriangleright GOD IS WITH US and helps us do what he asks us to do. God was with Joshua and helped him lead God's people, the way I was with you and helped you go through the obstacle course.

BIBLE EXPLORATION

God Helps Joshua Lead

What You'll Do

Gather a group of 2-year-olds together. Blow the whistle. Then hold it up.

Say: This is a whistle. Many people use whistles to lead people. Police officers, coaches, and band leaders all use whistles to tell people when to start and stop. I'm going to lead you in a game using the whistle. When I blow the whistle, look at me and do what I do. I'll change my actions each time the whistle blows. Watch and listen very carefully.

Blow the whistle, and begin patting your head with your hands. Encourage children to join you. Blow the whistle again, and clap your hands in a steady rhythm. Once children have joined you in clapping, blow the whistle again, and pat your knees. To end the game, blow the whistle one more time, and sit quietly with your hands in your lap.

Say: You followed me as I led you. You're such good listeners! Open your Bible to Joshua 1:1-11, and show children the words. Tell them the Bible is God's special book. Say: The Bible says God's people learned to follow Moses. Then they had to learn to follow their new leader, Joshua. Hold up the Joshua paper doll. God chose Joshua to lead the Israelites into the Promised Land. Many Israelites were scared because there were giants in the land. Have a 2-year-old come and stand next to the Joshua paper doll. Giants can be big and scary! But Joshua wasn't afraid. One at a time, allow children to stand by the paper doll. Joshua knew God was with him and would help him with the giants and everything else. ▶ GOD IS WITH US and helps us, too.

Help With My Day

What You'll Do

Call one or two 2-year-olds to play this game.

Say: God was with Joshua and helped him every day. Here are some cards that show parts of your day. Take the cards out of one of the envelopes, and spread the cards faceup in front of a child. Talk about the pictures; then mix them up. Help the child decide which picture goes first, second, and last. Quickly move through the cards, helping the child lay out the correct sequence. When he or she is finished, say: You did a good job playing this game. Each of these pictures reminds us that ► GOD IS WITH US and helps us all day long.

Let children put the cards back in the envelopes. They can remove the cards and continue to play the game on their own or color the cards if they wish.

Helping Hands

What You'll Do

Have children clean their hands before this activity. Give each child a non-latex plastic glove to put on. Most children will need help getting their fingers in the right holes.

Say: \blacktriangleright GOD IS WITH US and gives us a helping hand. Sometimes he helps us use our helping hands to help others. God is with us and helps us do what he asks us to do—just as God was with Joshua and helped Joshua.

After all the children have a glove on one hand, help them use the gloved hand to fill another glove with cereal from the bowl. Tape the filled gloves closed. Encourage each child to give his or her glove filled with cereal to another child and to tell that child, "God is with us. He gives us a helping hand." You may need to prompt children if they can't remember all the words to say. Have children take home the snack they received to eat later, or if there's time, you could let them eat part of their snack now.

Navigating Independence

Soon after your child learns to talk, you'll hear the famous words "I want to do it." Remind your child that you're there and offer help, but wait to be asked before you step in. Sometimes you can trade a favor with a child who needs your assistance. For example, as you dress, let your child put a piece of jewelry or a shoe on you; then encourage your child to let you fasten the snap on his or her pants in return. Your willingness to accept his or her help sets the stage for him or her to do the same. That, in turn, can set the stage for your child's willingness to accept God's help as well.

Helping Hands

Help your child wash his or her hands. Give your child a disposable plastic glove to put on.

Say: God is with us and gives us a helping hand. Sometimes he helps us use our helping hands to help others. God is with us and helps us do what he asks us to do—just as God was with Joshua and helped Joshua.

Help your child use the gloved hand to fill another glove with cereal. Tape the filled glove closed. Encourage your child to give the glove filled with cereal to someone and to tell that person that God is with us and he gives us a helping hand.

Use these ideas to help your child become a FaithWeaver:

- Provide opportunities for your child to master a new challenge or skill, such as putting on a sock or adding another block to make a bigger wall. Express delight in helping your child, and remind your child that God is with us and likes to help us, too.
- As you read to your child about the people and events in the Bible, point out how God was with the people in the Bible. This is one small way children learn that God's nature is unchanging.
