

# Jesus Teaches About Commitment Mark 8:31-38

Your infants, toddlers, and 2-year-olds don't have the developmental understanding to know what a commitment is or even what it means to follow Jesus. But they do enjoy playing "follow-me" games. When you point to a part of your body and say, "Here are my eyes. Show me your eyes," they can do it and will follow your lead. When you show them a picture of Jesus and say, "Here is Jesus," you're helping them learn about someone they haven't met yet but are learning to trust and believe in.

# Jesus Teaches About Commitment

Mark 8:31-38



BIBLE BACKGROUND FOR LEADERS

# Jesus Rebuked Peter

The disciples were likely counting on a great earthly kingdom in which Jesus would lead the Jews in overthrowing the Romans and would place his disciples in important positions. Jesus' statements didn't go along with those expectations! Peter wanted Jesus to change his mind and forget all this talk about dying.

Peter's thinking was based on wrong assumptions because he saw things from a purely human point of view. Here we see a clear statement about what it means to follow Jesus. Too often we think of God as a powerful being who can help us advance our own agendas. Instead, truly following Jesus means listening to what he says, discovering his will for our lives, and then obediently following, no matter how attractive or repulsive that may seem to us at the time.

# Jesus Challenged the Crowd

A crowd had apparently gathered to hear Jesus, and he wanted to clarify his meaning. This is not a description of what some call "easy believism." Instead, Jesus points out how denying oneself means turning away from selfish, self-protective attitudes and seeking the true humility and faith God wants to see in us.

What does it mean to take up your cross? For Jesus' disciples to each take up his own cross didn't mean just to endure suffering. It meant to accept fully the suffering they would face because of their faith in Christ. Jesus wanted his disciples to know that their faith came with a cost.

#### Stand Firm in Faith

As he spoke of what it means to follow him, Jesus knew that many in the crowd around him wouldn't

be followers he would recognize as his own when he returns. Our generation is much like that of Jesus' day. People who claim to be religious—or even Christian—often shy away from bold witnessing for Jesus. It's easy to say you believe in God, but it's much more difficult to confess you're a Jesus-following Christian.

### **The Jesus Connection**

Humans are willing to sacrifice a lot for the sake of those they love. Your relationship with Jesus *will* require sacrifice, risk, and loyal commitment—but it's all worth it!

How can you take up your cross? Try living out the "Joy" acronym: Pray about one specific way you'll put *Jesus* first (such as spending time with him first thing each day), put *others* second (such as washing a friend's car), and put *yourself* last (such as giving up time watching TV in order to help someone else). # Sing and Celebrate

# Come After Jesus

### What You'll Do

As crawlers are playing on the floor or as you hold an infant, show the "Follow Jesus" teaching picture you prepared.

Say: See the people? They're following Jesus. Our Bible tells us to follow Jesus. Watch Jesus move down the road. Help babies touch Jesus, and move the figure slowly along as babies touch. Good for you! We ▶ FOLLOW JESUS.

## Reach and Touch

### What You'll Do

Lay a baby on his or her back on a blanket on the floor. Hold a toy above the baby just within reach of his or her hands. Move the toy back and forth. Encourage the baby to follow the toy with his or her eyes and try to reach out for it. Then hold the toy near baby's feet, and try to get the baby to kick at it.

As the baby tracks the toy, softly say this rhyme:

Watch and follow Jesus Every single day. Watch and follow Jesus, He will lead your way.

Afterward, say: ▶ FOLLOW JESUS.

# Toy Tracking

### What You'll Do

Lay an infant on his or her tummy on a blanket on the floor. Set a toy just out of reach, and encourage the baby to try to get the toy. Cheer when the baby reaches the toy.

Say: Good for you; you followed the toy. You can follow Jesus, too. We ▶ FOLLOW

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**JESUS.** For an older infant, hold the toy just out of reach and move it away as the baby gets closer. Repeat this a few times, being sensitive to each baby's tolerance level, and then let the baby grasp and hold the toy.

# Go With God!

### What You'll Do

Open your Bible to Mark 8:31-38. Show children the words and tell them the Bible is God's special book.

Say: The Bible tells us about Jesus and his friends. Hold up the teaching picture. Look, here's Jesus now! His friends know Jesus is good. They follow Jesus. See? Wherever Jesus walks, people follow him. We can follow him, too. ▶ FOLLOW JESUS.

Move the figure of Jesus along the path forward and backward as toddlers "chase" the figure with their fingers. Vary the pace and talk about following fast, slow, up the path, or down the path. Then let toddlers take turns carefully moving the Jesus figure down the path as you hold the loop on the back of the teaching picture to keep the figure from pulling through.

# Come and Get Me!

#### What You'll Do

Begin to crawl or slowly run away from a toddler.

Say: Follow me! Follow me! Come catch me! Stop now and then, and allow yourself to be caught. Hug the toddler and repeat the activity again. Jesus wants us to follow him. ► FOLLOW JESUS.

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# **Mirrored Movements**

### What You'll Do

Give one or more toddlers each a toy to hold.

Say: Follow me. Do what I do. Then have toddlers imitate you in the following motions:

- Hug the toy.
- Swing the toy back and forth.
- Put the toy on the floor.
- Hold the toy above your head.
- Dance with the toy.

Praise your toddlers.

Say: Very good! You followed me! You can follow Jesus, too. ▶ FOLLOW JESUS.

# **Faithful Followers**

#### What You'll Do

Place the "Follow Jesus" teaching picture on the floor in one corner of your room and the "People Follow Jesus" poster on the floor in a different corner of your room. Gather a group of children together near the "Follow Jesus" teaching picture.

Open your Bible to Mark 8:31-38. Show children the words and tell them the Bible is God's special book.

Say: The Bible tells us about Jesus and his friends. Jesus' friends knew Jesus is good. Jesus wants us to follow him. Let's make a "Follow Jesus" parade. Hold the "Cutout of Jesus' Face" up high, and lead a parade as you play the song "Follow, Follow Jesus" (track 3 on the CD). Let the children take turns holding the image of Jesus' face.

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When you're finished marching, have children gather around the "People Follow Jesus" poster. Hold up the poster.

Say: Jesus wanted people to follow him when he asked. Jesus told people not to wait to follow him. He may have said, "Follow me even when you're sad." Let's pretend to be sad. Lead the children in crying. Jesus may have said, "Follow me even when you're mad." Let's pretend to be mad. Lead the children in making angry sounds. He may have said, "Follow me when you're happy!" Let's be happy! Lead the children in laughing and cheering. Then help children place "Smiley Face" stickers on the people in the crowd on the poster.

Lead children in a parade back to the "Follow Jesus" teaching picture, and have them sit around it.

Say: You did a great job following me! No matter what happens, we can follow Jesus, just as the people followed Jesus. See? Move the figure of Jesus attached to the teaching picture down the path. Let each child take a turn moving the figure. FOLLOW JESUS.

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# Under, Over, and Around

#### What You'll Do

Expand the obstacle course used during your music time by adding a large pillow, a few chairs grouped together, and a masking tape line on the floor. Invite children to crawl under the table, around the large pillow, between the chairs, and along the line. You may need to physically direct some 2-year-olds. Praise children for following your directions as they travel through the obstacle course.

Say: You did a good job following my directions! You're learning to follow Jesus, too. ▶ FOLLOW JESUS.

# Follow the Leader

### What You'll Do

Give each child a "Follow Jesus" handout and a crayon. Have each child remove a shoe and sock from one foot. Help each child trace the bare foot onto the pathway following Jesus. Remind children that Jesus is good and that they can **FOLLOW JESUS.**

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# **Growing With Jesus**



Y our child learned he or she can follow Jesus (from Mark 8:31-38). Your child participated in one of the following activities today. You can use these activities with your child to help your child grow with Jesus throughout the week.

#### **INFANT**

### Toy Tracking

Place your infant on his or her tummy on a blanket on the floor. Place a toy just out of reach, and encourage your baby to try to get the toy. Cheer when your baby reaches the toy.

Say: Good for you; you followed the toy. You can follow Jesus. We follow Jesus.

For an older infant, hold the toy just out of reach and move it away as your baby gets closer. Then let your baby grasp and hold the toy.

# Under, Over, and Around

Use a table, pillows, chairs, and masking tape to create a small obstacle course. Direct your child to crawl under the table, around the large pillow, between the chairs, and along the line. You may need to physically direct your child. Praise your child for following your directions as he or she travels through the obstacle course.

Say: You did a good job following my directions! You are learning to follow Jesus, too. We can follow Jesus.



### Model Behavior

Whether we like it or not, children follow and imitate our ways as they grow up. It may be cute to see children mimic hand expressions or repeat phrases commonly used, but when children pick up bad habits, cuteness quickly wears off. Remember that your child learns about following Jesus by following your actions and attitudes. Take this responsibility seriously as you model the love and kindness of Jesus to those around you.



- Place your infant in a semi-upright position, and move a toy from left to right as an encouragement to follow the toy with his or her eyes and reach for it.
- Stand in front of a mirror with your child, make crazy movements, and try to copy each other. Talk about the kinds of things Jesus did with his followers, such as praying, eating, and helping others.
- Let your child be the leader and play Follow the Leader together. Then switch roles. Talk about what it's like to be the leader and what it's like to be the follower.
