

Jesus Explains Why God Sent Him John 3:12-21

od so loved us that he gave his Son to the entire world—infants, toddlers, and 2-year-olds included. How can we convey such a great, yet complex, concept to help our little ones know how much God loves them? Young children don't understand abstract ideas. Just as they need their food to be cut into very small pieces, they need to have spiritual concepts broken down into very small bites. This lesson provides games, songs, and activities that will give each child in your care a simple understanding of a complex truth: God loves everyone, and Jesus came to show that love to us.

Jesus Explains Why God Sent Him

John 3:12-21



BIBLE BACKGROUND

Nicodemus Sought Jesus

In this passage, Jesus is talking with Nicodemus, a Pharisee and a member of the Sanhedrin, the Jewish religious ruling council. Jesus launched into the conversation by making it clear that new birth is the only way to God's kingdom. For Nicodemus, a strict follower of the Law who thought obedience to a set of rules was his ticket to heaven, the concept of a "new birth" was tough to grasp. He had trouble accepting that all his good works and intentions wouldn't get him into God's kingdom.

Jesus Summarized God's Plan of Salvation

Jesus' reference to Moses' lifting up the snake in the desert refers to a time God sent poisonous snakes among the Israelites to punish them for rebelling against him. Those who had been bitten were dying. But God in his mercy instructed Moses to make a snake of bronze and lift it up on a pole where all could see it, promising safety to all who looked upon it. All who believed God and looked at the snake were spared from death. In the same way, Jesus would be lifted up on the cross, and as people looked to him in faith, they would be spared from eternal death for their sins.

Why did God send his own Son to die an agonizing death on the cross? The answer is clear in verse 16: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." In this sentence, Jesus summarizes God's entire plan of salvation. What amazing love!

We Must Respond in Faith

Jesus' message for Nicodemus and for us today is that following religious rules won't win us God's favor.

God has a different plan, because all the good we can ever do won't wipe out a single sin. Only Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, which paid the death penalty for us, makes it possible for us to enter heaven. And only our response in faith to that gift and to the Holy Spirit working in our lives will seal the deal.

The Jesus Connection

There are many awesome "benefits" of a relationship with Jesus, but this is the ultimate one: We can be born again! A new life, a fresh start, a clean slate!

John 3:16 is so familiar that it's tempting to skim it without taking its full meaning to heart. So stop for a moment and reread it. How do Jesus' words impact you? What questions do you have? Pray about your thoughts and questions. You can write your prayer here

What You'll Do

Set out the toys. Sit near a baby, and pull a toy toward the two of you. Straighten the ribbon and encourage the baby to pull the toy.

Say: Pull, pull, and reach! After baby has played with the toy, repeat the activity again. Thank you, God, for reaching us and sending Jesus. ▶ JESUS CAME TO SHOW GOD'S LOVE.

Ensure ribbons do not get wrapped around the baby's neck. Set the toys out of children's reach once the baby loses interest.

He's a Godsend!

What You'll Do

Gather a group of toddlers together. Open your Bible to John 3:12-21. Show children the words and tell them the Bible is God's special book.

Say: God loves everyone in the world. He sent Jesus, his Son, to show us his love. Jesus showed us how to love. JESUS CAME TO SHOW GOD'S LOVE. Show the teaching picture "Jesus Loves the World" to the toddlers. Pictures of Jesus are hiding behind these doors. Let's find out what Jesus is doing.

Invite toddlers to help you open the doors. Discuss what Jesus is doing in each picture.

Close your time by thanking God for his love and for sending Jesus to show us his love.



Search and Rescue

Tip You may want to have more than one box so several toddlers can play this game at the same time.

What You'll Do

Set a few small toys in front of the toddlers. Show children how to drop the toys into the hole in the tissue box. Shake the box. Then help toddlers reach in and retrieve the toys from the box.

Say: Reach into the dark hole, and pull out the toy! God sent Jesus to pull us out of sadness and to pull us close to him.

JESUS CAME TO SHOW GOD'S LOVE.

Thank you, Jesus! Most toddlers will want to repeat this activity over and over. You can repeat the words, "We come out of sadness...and close to Jesus!" as they pull out the toys.

What You'll Do

Growing With Jesus



Your child learned that Jesus came to show God's love (from John 3:12-21). Your child participated in one of the following activities today. You can use these activities with your child to help your child grow with Jesus throughout the week.

INFANT

Tug the Toys

Cut two or three 24-inch lengths of ribbon. Tie a toy onto each ribbon. Sit near your baby, and pull the toy toward the two of you. Straighten the ribbon and encourage your baby to pull the toy.

Say: Pull, pull, and reach!
After baby has played with the toy, repeat the activity again. Thank you, God, for reaching out to us and sending your Son.
Jesus came to show us God's love.

TODDLER

Caring Capers

Tell your child to close his or her eyes as you hide somewhere in the room. Once you're hidden, tell your toddler to open his or her eyes.

Say: Come and find me. Wait for your child to find you, and then give him or her a big hug. God loves you! God finds his children like you found me. Repeat the game. God sent his Son, Jesus, to show us his love.

2-YEAR-OLD

Lifesaver

Use masking tape to form a large circle on the floor. Place a stuffed animal inside the pretend "lake."

Say: Look! The animal is in the water, and he doesn't like it. Let's help him out! Use a Hula-Hoop or your hands to pull the toy to "safety." Repeat the game. We helped our animal friend. God sent Jesus to help us. Jesus came to show us God's love.



Saving Love

•••••

Small children know fear and then the comfort of being "rescued" by someone they trust. Think of how relieved they are when someone comes into the room after they've been crying. As your child experiences the security of your love, consider how to help provide understanding of Jesus' comforting love. Use hugs and words as reminders of your love, and talk frequently about the love that God has for all of us.

Use these ideas to help your child become a FaithWeaver:

- Hide behind a chair or sofa, and call out, "Help me! I'm lost!" When your child comes near, reach out and offer a hug. Say, "You found me! Jesus came to help us and show us God's love."
- Review the verse "God so loved the world." Personalize the verse with your family names: "God so loved [child's name]. God so loved Mommy. Thank you, thank you, God."
