Show one or two toddlers your Bible, opened to Acts 5. Put the Bible next to you along with the nesting cups.

Say: **The Bible tells us that Jesus' friends went everywhere telling people about Jesus.** Hold up the nesting cups. **When Jesus' friends would meet someone, they would tell that person about Jesus and say, "Jesus loves you!" Let's say that**



together: Jesus loves you! Let a toddler remove the top cup from the stack to reveal the next cup. **When Jesus' friends would meet another person, they would say, "Jesus loves you!"** Let's say that: **Jesus loves you!** Let another toddler remove the cup from the stack to reveal the next cup. **What would the friends say to this person? "Jesus loves you!"** Remove the cup from the stack to reveal the last cup. **Let's tell this person about Jesus, too: Jesus loves you!** The four cups should now be lined up along the floor. **Look! Lots of people know about Jesus now! God wants us to spread his love to everyone. We can tell people about Jesus' love, too.**

Hold hands with the toddlers, and ask them to bow their heads.

Pray: **Lord, help us to share your love and ► TELL OTHERS ABOUT JESUS. In Jesus' name, amen.**

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Help a toddler stack wooden or plastic blocks one on top of the other as high as he or she can before the blocks fall.

Say: **Each time we added a block, our tower got taller. Every time we tell someone about Jesus, the kingdom of God gets bigger and bigger. God wants us to ► TELL OTHERS ABOUT JESUS.**

Stand up tall. (*Have children repeat "Stand up tall," reach hands over heads, and stand on tiptoe.*)


Shout to them all. (*Have children shout the words "Shout to them all."*)



2 BIBLE EXPLORATION

Go and Tell

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Gather the 2-year-olds together. Open your Bible to Acts 5.

Say: **Point to a friend in this group. Isn't it fun to have friends? Jesus had some special friends. They were called the disciples. The Bible tells us that the disciples went everywhere telling people about Jesus.** Place the nesting cups on the floor in front of you.


When the disciples would meet someone, they would tell that person about Jesus and say, “Jesus loves you!” Let's say that together to this person. Point to the top nesting cup. **Jesus loves you! Now that person can be a disciple and share God's love, too.** Remove the top cup from the stack to reveal the next cup. **What will we tell this person? Jesus loves you! Now we have two more people to help us tell about Jesus!** Remove the cup from the stack to reveal the next cup. **What would the disciples say to this person? Jesus loves you!** As you point to each cup, count aloud with the children. **One, two, three. Now we have three more people to help us tell others about Jesus.** Remove the cup from the stack to reveal the last cup. **Let's tell this person about Jesus, too. Jesus loves you!** The four cups should now be lined up along the floor.

Look how many people now know about Jesus! God wants us to spread his love to everyone. He wants us to be his disciples and ► TELL OTHERS ABOUT JESUS and his love.

Line up the twos.

Say: **Let's be disciples and tell our friends about Jesus.** Instruct the first child in line to turn to the child behind him or her and say, “Jesus loves you.” That child will then turn to the next child and say, “Jesus loves you.” The children should pass the message until everyone in the line has had a turn. Be sure to have the last child in line tell the first child.

Say: **You did a great job telling your friends about Jesus. God wants us to tell everyone about Jesus. Let's join hands and pray. God, help us be good disciples and tell other people about your Son, Jesus. In Jesus' name, amen.**

Tell the Good News

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Working with one 2-year-old at a time, help him or her dot glue on the newspaper square and place it on the "Happy News!" handout beside the happy face. Then let the child dip the heart-shaped sponge in paint and press it onto the handout beside the picture of Jesus.

Say: **Let's read our picture-sentence together: "Happy news! Jesus loves!" Who does Jesus love?** Let the child respond. **God wants us to tell the good news about Jesus to everyone.**




Use these ideas to help your child become a FaithWeaver:

- Use a play telephone to let your child pretend to call friends and tell them about Jesus. Then place a real call to a grandparent or friend. Remind your child to say, "Jesus loves you." Reinforce to your child that everyone can be told about Jesus.
- Together make this fun snack as a reminder to tell others about Jesus. Slice an apple, and put two slices on a plate. (These will be lips.) Spread cream cheese on the slices, and then place cereal squares to represent teeth. Point to the apple mouth, and say, "God wants us to use our mouths to tell other people about Jesus."
