What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Hold up the two stick puppets, and move them so that the babies can track the puppets' movements with their eyes.

Say: **Here's old Naomi, who loved the girl Ruth.
Ruth loved Naomi, and that is the truth!
Both women trusted in God for their care,
And our God provided even more than was fair.
A husband for Ruth, someone to love,
Boaz—a gift from our God up above.
God was their hope; God's your hope, too!
Hope in the Lord, for he always comes through.
We can ► HOPE IN GOD!**


Hope, Hope, Hope

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Seat a baby in front of you on the floor or other flat surface. Sing this song to the tune of “Row, Row, Row Your Boat” (not on CD) as you perform rowing motions with baby's arms:

 **Hope, hope, hope in God.
There's hope for every day!
Hope, hope, hope in God.
Clap, and shout “hooray!”** (*Clap baby's hands together, and then lift his or her arms up high.*)

Say: ► **HOPE IN GOD, little one!**



H-O-P-E

What You'll Do

Hold a baby on your lap, facing outward, as you do the following rhyme together:

Say: **H is for your little hands that can do God's will.** (*Clap baby's hands together.*)

O is for the only God. Rest in him; be still. (*Hold baby's hands still.*)

P is for the patience that only God can send. (*Pat baby's hands on thighs.*)

E is for "Everything will work out in the end." (*Hold baby's arms outstretched, and then cross them over chest. Repeat motions several times.*)

Put your **▶ HOPE IN GOD.** (*Give baby a hug.*)




We Can Have Hope

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Invite two toddlers to sit down with you. Place your Bible in front of the children. Have the cereal tray nearby.

Say: **The Bible tells us of many people who hoped in God. Can you find some people in my Bible?** Let the children look for the Ruth and Naomi puppets. Give each child a puppet as you say: **This is Ruth, and this is Naomi. They had great hope in God. When they were hungry, God provided grain for Ruth to pick up. Would you like to pick up some grain?** Allow the children to pick up several pieces of cereal. **God sent a man named Boaz to take care of Ruth and Naomi. Boaz filled Ruth's shawl with grain to take to Naomi.** Drape a hand towel over one of the toddler's shoulders. **You be Ruth. Here is a shawl. Can I fill your shawl with grain to take to our friend Naomi?** Have the toddler hold the towel with both hands. Pour some cereal flakes into the towel, and encourage the toddler to deliver the cereal in the towel to the other child. Encourage the child pretending to be Naomi to say, "Thank you, Ruth. Thank you, Boaz. Thank you, God." Give the children a chance to exchange roles.

Say: **Soon Ruth married Boaz. The whole village saw how God takes care of his people. The villagers said, "Praise the Lord." Can you say "Praise the Lord"?** Encourage the children to repeat the words. **Ruth and Naomi hoped in God. You can ► HOPE IN GOD, too.**



3 WEAVING FAITH INTO LIFE

Buckets of Hope

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Say: **Boaz told his harvesters to leave some “good-to-eat” grain for Ruth to gather. I hope you can find something good to eat in this rice.** Let one child at a time dig down in the rice to find a cookie. Allow the children to find and eat one cookie at a time. **You hoped for something good. What a surprise you found! God has lots of good surprises for us to find. We can ► HOPE IN GOD.**

Show Your Hope

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Sing this action song to the tune of “This Little Light of Mine” (not on CD), encouraging children to do the motions indicated in the words:

 **I have hope in God.
I’m gonna nod my head.
I have hope in God.
I’m gonna nod my head,
Nod my head, nod my head, nod my head.**

For “nod my head” substitute the words “clap my hands,” “stomp my feet,” or “turn around.”

Say: **We can ► HOPE IN GOD.** Nod your head one more time.



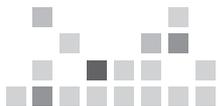

EXPLORATION

Ruth Had Hope

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Open your Bible to the book of Ruth. Show the stick puppets.

Ask:

- Have you been to a new place before?

Say: Ruth and Naomi went to a new place. They didn't know anyone there. They needed to make new friends. This is what they did. Do what I do.

- Ruth and Naomi went to a new place. (Walk in place.)
- They didn't know a single face. (Shake your head.)
- They wanted to make new friends. (Shake hands with person next to you.)
- They needed food to eat. (Bring fingers and thumb to mouth.)
- They needed a place to sleep. (Lay head on folded hands.)
- Ruth and Naomi went to a new place. (Walk in place.)
- They didn't know a single face. (Shake your head.)
- Ruth and Naomi had hope in God. (Point overhead.)
- They knew he'd take care of them. (Hug self.)
- God helped them make new friends. (Shake hands with person next to you.)
- God helped them find food to eat. (Bring fingers and thumb to mouth.)
- God gave them a place to sleep. (Lay head on folded hands.)
- Ruth and Naomi had hope in God. (Point overhead.)
- They knew he'd take care of them. (Hug self.)

Say: God brought Ruth and Naomi to a new home and gave them everything they needed. God sent Ruth to be Boaz's wife, and they lived happily together for God. Ruth and Naomi hoped in God when they needed many things. We can ► HOPE IN GOD, too.





Hoops for Hope

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Lay three hula-hoops on the floor touching each other. Let one 2-year-old at a time jump from one hoop into the next. As the child jumps into the first hoop, say: **Hope**. As he or she jumps into the second hoop, say: **In**. As he or she jumps into the third hoop, say: **God**. Make sure to allow each child to finish the course.

Ask:

- What do you hope God will do?

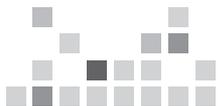
Affirm that God takes care of our every need, just as he did for Ruth and Naomi. Say: **It's good to ► HOPE IN GOD.**

We Have Hope in God

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Work with one child at a time.

Say: **We always have hope in God. The cross reminds us of hope.** Dip a sponge into the paint. To minimize mess, attach clothespins to the sponges for the children to hold. Let the 2-year-old dab the sponge all over the bottom of the paper, covering the masking tape. Wait for the paint to set a bit. Then say: **I'm going to take the tape off your picture. I hope I'll still be able to see the cross!** Remove the masking tape, and a cross print will remain. Show the child the cross. **No matter what happens, we can always have ► HOPE IN GOD.**

Growing With Jesus



Hope in God

Your greatest investment as a Christian parent is in the hope that your child will come into a full relationship with Jesus Christ. The little prayers you say together, the songs you sing, and your commitment to bring your child into God's house are all concrete evidence of your hope in God.

Your child learned to hope in God (from Ruth 2–4). Your child participated in one of the following activities today. You can use these activities with your child to help your child grow with Jesus throughout the week.

INFANT

H-O-P-E

Hold your baby on your lap, facing outward, as you do the following rhyme together:

H is for your little hands that can do God's will.

(Clap baby's hands together.)

O is for the only God. Rest in him; be still.

(Hold baby's hands still.)

P is for the patience that only God can send. *(Pat baby's hands on thighs.)*

E is for "Everything will work out in the end." *(Hold baby's arms outstretched, and then cross them over chest. Repeat motions several times.)*

Put your hope in God.

(Give baby a hug.)

TODDLER

Show Your Hope

Sing this action song to the tune of "This Little Light of Mine," encouraging your child to do the motions indicated in the words:

**I have hope in God.
I'm gonna nod my head.
I have hope in God.
I'm gonna nod my head,
Nod my head, nod my head, nod my head.**

For "nod my head" substitute the words "clap my hands," "stomp my feet," or "turn around."

Say: **We can hope in God.** Nod your head one more time.

2-YEAR-OLD

Rings of Hope

Use masking tape to make three large rings on the floor, touching each other. Let your 2-year-old jump from one ring into the next. As your child jumps into the first ring, say: **Hope.** As he or she jumps into the second ring, say: **In.** As he or she jumps into the third ring, say: **God.** Make sure to allow your child to finish the course.


What do you hope God will do? Affirm that God takes care of our every need, just as he did for Ruth and Naomi. **It's good to hope in God.**

Use these ideas to help your child become a FaithWeaver:

- With your child, fill a small envelope with a treat. Say that you are going to hide the envelope, and when your child finds it, he or she can have the treat. Allow time to search for the envelope, and then help your child find it. Remind your child that you care about what he or she hopes for and that God cares about our hopes, too.
- Celebrate our hope in God by singing this song to the tune of "Row, Row, Row Your Boat":

Hope, hope, hope in God.	Hope, hope, hope in God.
There's hope for every day!	Clap, and shout "hooray!"
